2025 GOLF DAY HONOREE

Fr. Daniele Criscione is a native of Ragusa, Sicily. He is the Mission Center Director of the PIME U.S. Mission Center and serves to bridge the connection between PIME's supporters in the U.S.A. and those who desperately need our help in the missions. Fr. Daniele's path to the priesthood is a unique one, as just after he was ordained a deacon in 2011, he was diagnosed with an aggressive form of Leukemia known as AML. He likes to think of himself as "American on the inside" as a bone marrow transplant from a donor in Los Angeles saved his life.

In 2013, Fr. Daniele was ordained a PIME Priest, receiving his first assignment in Milan, working as Director of Vocations at the PIME

Milan Mission Center. Four years later, he received his mission assignment in Detroit. Since 2019, he has served as PIME U.S. Mission Center Director.

Fr. Daniele's outgoing personality and love for God's Word are often on display as he leads PIME Events or when he says mass around the Metro Detroit area. Now that the PIME U.S. Mission Center has moved from Detroit to Farmington Hills, Fr. Daniele is looking to bring PIME Events to the Center and make it a central hub of mission activity in the Archdiocese of Detroit. He always adheres to the notion that, "You make PIME!" We make our impact on the missions and those who need our help together.

From tee-off until dusk, golfers have the complete use of the facilities at each of the clubs. Your ticket provides you pre-paid access to golf, complimentary driving range privileges, carts, and participation in the Helicopter Ball Drop raffle. You will be permitted to play **only** 18 holes of golf.

Each of the clubs will offer a continental breakfast; lunch at the turn is at an outdoor grill or club room. An open bar is located in the club room. Dinner will be served ONLY at the Golden Fox. Facilities at Coyote and Tanglewood golf course will close at approximately 5 pm, at which time everyone will join together at the **Golden Fox** (Fox Hills Golf Club) for dinner (Starting at 4 pm), the prize drawing and the evening's activities. Ticket price per person is \$425.

STARTING TIME - SHOTGUN START AT ALL 3 GOLF COURSES

All starting times have been pre-assigned to each Golf Day selling team. Golfers will tee off from a shotgun start; starting times will vary by course. Registration will be at the golf course where you have an assigned starting tee time.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration at 10:00 am - 12:00 pm for noon flight and 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm for 3pm flight on Tuesday, July 15th, 2025, at the Detroit Gun Club. Lunch will be served at 11:00 am followed by a short safety meeting. Sport clay shooting will feature two shotgun start flights - at 12:00 and 3:00 PM. A steak dinner will be served and "White Bird Prizes" will be drawn. Tickets include 100 shells, lunch, dinner, and 2 drink tickets. A cash bar is available. Warmup and extra rounds will be offered preceding and following the main event. A box of shells can be purchased for \$25 per person in addition to the main ticket. Tickets are \$400 per person and \$1,900 a foursome with a shooting station sign. \$135 DINNER ONLY tickets are available.

NO GUN RENTALS WILL BE OFFERED all shooters must bring their own guns and all PARTICIPANTS MUST BE REGISTERED BEFORE THE DAY OF THE EVENT.
